This is one of several books I downloaded on the subject of the Sikh history and belief system. This book contains a lot of information on both and presents it in a well written and well organized manner. There is material that compliments other works I've read, and other material that contrasts. While it may not be the definitive work on the subject, I feel that it was definitely worth reading.

The text of the book itself is worth having -- but this is not the edition you want. It is a photomechanical reprint of a copy in a University of California library, reproducing all the library markings and the pencil markings of readers. The publisher's description cleverly avoids identifying it as a photomechanical reprint, while using sly wording that, after the fact, can be pointed to as a defense to the publisher's fraud. It costs far, far too much for such a cheap object. Find another
