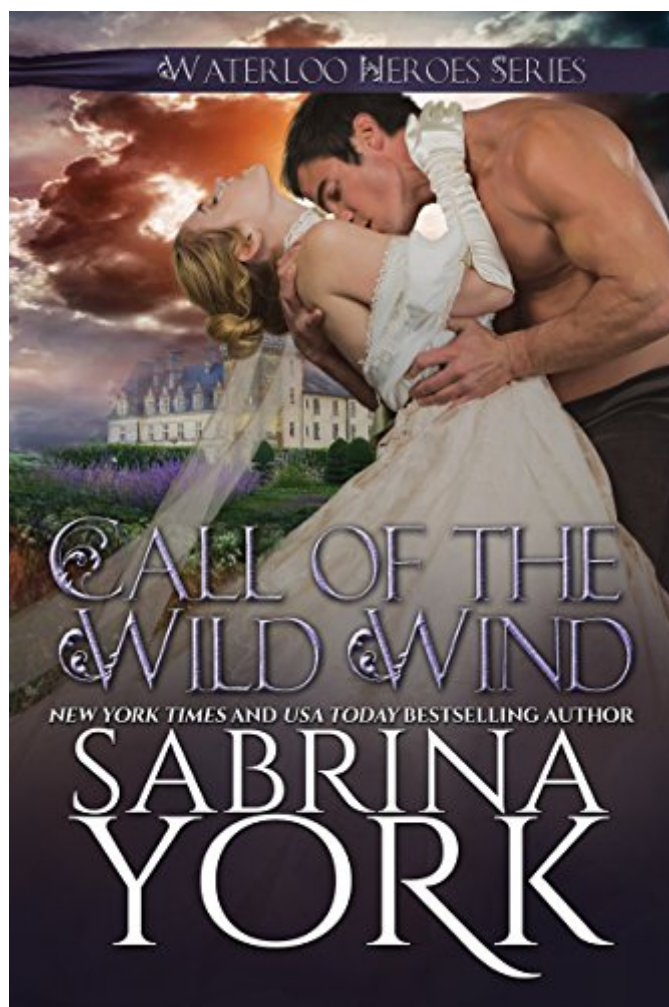


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Call Of The Wild Wind (Waterloo Heroes Book 2)

Determined to see if this "John" is her Peter, Britannia sneaks out under the guise of a young boy. But again, fate intervenes, and her journey is abruptly halted and her course is altered. Will Lady Britannia find her Peter? Will the Earl of Wick win the heart of Lady Britannia? Will true love conquer all? The clock is ticking and the curse is almost upon them! Call of the Wild Wind by Sabrina York is a fairly quick read, perfect for those with limited time for reading. Ms York has once again delivered a well written book. I can always count on a smooth read from this author. I love the characters in this book, they make it a fantastic read. Britannia and Charles' story has plenty of drama and humor to hold the reader's attention. This is a clean read, no sexy bits. I enjoyed Call of the Wild Wind and look forward to my next book by Sabrina York. Call of the Wild Wind is book 2 in the Waterloo Heroes Series but can be read as a standalone. This is a complete book, not a cliff-hanger.

I've never read this author before and I'm pretty sure I won't again in the future either. I downloaded this as it was free on KU, plus I liked the fact that it was clean. The idea at the beginning was intriguing and I had high hopes. In the prologue we learn about a "magical" ring that is passed down through the ages from mother to daughter. If the wearer finds true love before she's 25 then the ring changes colour. If she doesn't find her true love then she's destined to be a spinster and die alone. At the start of the book, the h, a duke's daughter, is nearly 25 and pining for her fiance, who went missing after Waterloo and is presumed dead a year later. Nothing has been heard from him or about him during the past year. The h is still unwilling to accept the fact that he might be dead and on very scanty evidence from the H, she goes haring off to find him in Scotland. The H is a Scottish Earl and he believes that his groom is in the fact the h's lost fiance because of the similar appearances. He quite fancies the h but isn't willing to get involved. Obviously the h manages to sneak off to go and find her fiance without the H's help. Along the way she gets into trouble and the H comes across her and rescues her. My summary mightn't seem bad but honestly I'm not sure how I got through it. Firstly this is not a true historical romance as the writing is way too modern, as is the

behaviour of the characters. The h is seriously annoying. The plot had so many holes in it, that I wouldn't know where to start describing them. The things that happened at the end of the book are beyond credible and I cannot recommend this book.

In the aftermath of Waterloo, Britannia awaits the return of her fiancé. She feels that he is still alive but unable to return to her. When her brother's friend, the Earl of Wick, visits and sees a portrait of the missing Peter, he remarks that Peter bears an uncanny resemblance to John, his groom. Nothing will do but that she travel to Scotland to see for herself if John is her missing fiancé. Her parents forbid her to travel with Charles, the Earl, so she disguises herself as a boy and travels on the mail coach.

I loved how Britannia took control of her own destiny and didn't wait for her family to make decisions for her. Hilarious to watch how Charles tricks blew up in his face, trying to teach her a lesson by making her his valet without her knowing he was aware she was a girl! Loved the book! Patti Wissore

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
