

And also the crooked church characters and Winifred should have had more consequences!! However, overall I recommend this book!

The whole premise of their relationship was unrealistic and inorganic. In order to woo Loaghaire, Galen completely transformed himself and molded into whatever she needed, and she completely fell for it. This had the potential for a great story; however there wasn't much for them to discover about each other and cause them to fall in love. One horseback ride is never enough. I skipped

through until I got to the end and I'm not mad that I did.

I think this maybe one of the worst romance books I have purchased. Most love stories have conflict in the beginning, this was over the top, and I can't say when things turned romantic. I had no desire to read more after the 2nd chapter

I was so happy to finally be able to read the 2nd book in the series, to see what happened to Laoghaire. Recommend that you read the 1st book in this series first so that you are familiar with how Galen and Laoghaire first met. Good read.
